PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE ADOPTION OF NEW REGULATION

All citizens, specially the government agencies, municipal governments and public corporations, are hereby notified that the Forensic Sciences Institute of Puerto Rico proposes to amend a regulation to be known as

“REGLAMENTO DE COMPRAS Y SUBASTAS DEL INSTITUTO DE CIENCIAS FORENSES”

This regulation was adopted to establish the rules governing the application, approval and processing of purchases of supplies and non-personal services through formal auction procedure or other procedure that applies. The proposed amendment to this regulation aims to broaden the range of people who can compose the Auction Board in order to include former employees of the Institute to deliver their services Ad Honorem as members of the Board.

This amendment will be adopted pursuant to the dispositions of Act No. 13 July 24, 1985, as amended, which requires the formulation and adoption of regulation for processing of purchases of supplies and non-personal services; and Act No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, also known as the “Commonwealth of Puerto Rico Uniform Administrative Procedure Act”.
